FORTUNE 500 COMPANIES, 2020

Downtown is home to 9 of the 22 *Fortune* 500 companies headquartered in the Houston metro area, ranking Houston fourth in the U.S. behind New York (65), Chicago (33) and Dallas-Ft. Worth (24). The Houston Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) is home to 41 companies on the Fortune 1000 list. The largest movers on the Fortune 500 from 2019 to 2020 are Cheniere (up to #329 from #383), CenterPoint (up to #260 from #299) and Quanta Services (up to #261 from #282). □ Houston lost one contender from the list, Marathon Oil, which went from #456 to #538. Houston added one company to its Fortune 500 roster this year: Crown Castle International (moved from #513 to #496).
