FORTUNE 500 COMPANIES, 2018

Downtown is home to 10 of the 21 *Fortune 500* companies headquartered in Houston. Two Houston companies joined the *Fortune 500* this year, one of which is headquartered Downtown – Cheniere Energy. The Houston metro area ranks fourth in the country behind New York (74), Chicago (35) and Dallas-Ft. Worth (22). In total, Downtown is home to 63 companies on the 2018 *Fortune 500* List.

Seventy percent of downtown companies climbed in ranks from 2017 to 2018: *Enterprise Products Partners* moved from #122 (\$27 billion) to #105 (\$29.2 billion); *Plains GP Holdings, LP* moved from #141 (\$23.2 billion) to #115 (\$26.2 billion); *EOG Resources* moved from #356 (\$8.8 billion) to #270 (\$11.2 billion); *Targa Resources* moved from #402 (\$6.7 billion) to #307 (\$8.8 billion); *CenterPoint Energy* moved from #362 (\$7.4 billion) to #308 (\$9.6 billion); *Calpine* moved from #400 (\$6.5 billion) to #336 (\$8.8 billion); and *Cheniere* moved onto the list to #489 (\$5.6 billion). Oil and natural gas company, *EOG Resources* made the largest leap, climbing up 86 levels. The *Fortune 500* companies headquartered Downtown and their rankings are listed below:
